**BY LAWS OF
IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF INDIA**

- (I) The Name of the Association is Irrigation Association of India.
- (II) The Registered Office of the Association will be situated at MCCIA Building, Tilak Road, Pune-411 002. (Maharashtra)
- (III) Mission Statement. To hasten adoption of modern irrigation systems in all part of the country and achieve maximum water use efficiency.
- (IV) The Objectives for which the Association is established are:

(A) Main Objectives of the Association

1. The association, is a voluntary non-profit organisation formed to promote development, proper use and acceptance of irrigation equipment for all possible applications to promote water and soil conservation and more economical crop production through the use of irrigation to conserve energy through efficient design and operation of irrigation systems to enhance the environment by expanding efficient use of irrigation for landscape maintenance, dust and erosion control to collect and disseminate information regarding irrigation and value to members of the association to allied industries and to the public, to acquaint public and private agencies institutions no organisations with developments in the industry, and the part of the industry occupies in the Economy and Development of the nation, to conduct educational programmes regarding the industry and extend scholarship to promote research, development and extension work to reorganize outstanding contribution in promotion of modern irrigation systems, and to carry out such other lawful trade association activities as the general object may direct.

2. To promote and develop ethical practices and standards amongst the irrigation industries in India.

(B) Objectives incidental or Ancillary to the attainment of main objectives.

3. To regulate and standardise business practices in the irrigation industry.
4. To promote and safeguard the interest of India's irrigation industry in all its branches and by ail possible means and in particular by
 - 1) Providing a meeting place with facilities for the exchange of views of members and others interested in the trade and industry.
 - 2) Providing facilities for the communication, coordination of interest or co-operation with similar or allied associations or societies in other countries.
 - 3) Arranging and providing facilities for conferences, exhibitions, demonstrations, lecture excursions and other functions relating to irrigation industries.
 - 4) Establishing equipping and maintaining a suitable experimental laboratory and library for the benefit of its members and if possible for the general public.
 - 5) Investing, collecting and circulating information and statistics relating to the trade and industry.
 - 6) Educating the general public by all suitable means in the benefit and utility of irrigation from the industrial and utility points of view and
 - 7) Providing facilities and machinery for the settlement of disputes by arbitration.

5. To promote and to protect the interest of Irrigation industry in any or all of their branches and of those engaged or interested therein including the interest of manufacturers of all kinds of irrigation goods and articles useful or ancillary to the purpose of the said irrigation industry and to do everything necessary or expedient for all or any of these purpose including the negotiations and carrying through of amalgamation of any concerns interested in the trade and industry, the constituting management.
6. To enter into any arrangements with the Government of India or any foreign or local Government Chambers of Commerce, Municipalities Local Boards or any other public or private authorities that may seem conducive to all or any of the objectives of the Association.
7. To present officially the views of members on any matters affecting or likely to affect the irrigation industry to the Government of India. Local Government, Foreign Government, Chambers of Commerce and any other public or private authorities/Statutory Bodies.
8. To move the authorities concerned to accept strict policy in the import of irrigation goods from foreign countries and to give facilities for the import of requisite machinery and raw material and allied products for the trade or production of finished articles and for manufacture of necessary raw materials.
9. To promote or oppose legislative or other measures affecting the irrigation industry.
 - a) To publish an official journal of the Association giving prominence to its aims, objectives and activities and for, the spread of knowledge and information relating to the irrigation industry generally and to print and publish any advertisements, newspapers, periodicals, books, lectures or leaflets that may be deemed desirable.
- b) To make and from time to time alter, revoke, re-enact and enforce rules and bye-laws for the benefit and binding on the Association and / or it members, and in so far as may be requisite or expedient, to apply for statutory powers for the making, passing and enforcement of rules or bye-laws binding upon those interested in the irrigation industry.
10. To commence, prosecute, appear in, defend or compromise or give up all and every manner of proceeding, civil criminal or administrative or any arbitration or inquiry or proceedings before any commission for the protection or assistance of any members of the Association or any of them.
11. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange of otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property, rights or which may be deemed necessary convenient for any of the purposes of the Association and in particular to subscribe, to acquire and hold shares in at company or association whether incorporated or n having objectives altogether or in part similar to those of the association.
- 12 'To sell, improve, manage, develop, lease, mortgage, charge, hypothecate, dispose off or otherwise deal with all or any of the property, rights or privileges of the Association.
- 13 To take any gift or property whether subjects to any trust or not for any we or more of the objects of the Association.
- 14 To take any such steps by personal or written appeals or otherwise as may from time to time be deemed expedient for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the

Association in the shape of donation, entrance fees, annual subscription or otherwise.

- 15 To borrow or raise or secure the payment of money which may be required for the purpose of the Association in such manner as the Association may think fit and in particular by the issue of promissory notes, bonds, debentures or debenture stock, perpetual or otherwise charged upon all or any of the Association's property both present and future and to purchase redeem and pay off such securities in such manner as the Association may deem fit.
- 16 To invest and otherwise deal with the surplus moneys of the Association in such manner as may from time to time be determined by the Committee of the Association and to open and operate on savings or current or fixed deposit accounts with any bank or banks.
- 17 To draw, make accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of lading, railway receipts, warrants, debentures and other negotiable or transferable instruments or securities.
- 18 To provide for the welfare of the employees or ex-employees of the Association and wives, widows and families or dependants or connections of such persons and to give scholarships award or allow any pension, gratuity, compensation, grant of money, allowances, bonus or other payment to order benefit of such persons whether they have or have not a legal claim upon the Association and in particular to provide for the welfare of such persons by creating and from time to time subscribing or contributing to provident and other funds of trusts, and by providing or subscribing or contributing towards places of instruction and creation, hospitals dispensaries, medical and other

attendance and assistance and to contribute to charitable, benevolent or useful objects of a public character the support of which will tend to increase the repute or popularity of the Association among its members or the public.

- 19 To encourage or establish and maintain State Level Associations or branches or chapters either autonomous or affiliated to the Association at such places in India and on such terms as the Committee of the Association may deem suitable or expedient and control and regulate the policy, work and business of any such branches by rules, regulations or bye-laws from time to time to be made or varied by the, committee and federate with other association bodies, corporations, firms or persons having objectives altogether or in part similar to those of the Association on such terms and conditions as the Committee of the Association may deem fit.
- 20 To enter into any arrangement with any Government or authority, municipal local or otherwise, and to obtain from any such Government or authority and rights, privileges and concessions which the Association may think it desirable to obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply with any such arrangements, rights, privileges and concessions.
- 21 To procure the Association to be registered or recognized in any state, country or place, in any part of the world.
- 22 To act as arbitrator or to appoint arbitrators to act in the settlement of disputes arising out of transactions in or relating other allied industries and to adjust controversies and disputes between members as well as non-members of the association and act as arbitrators and umpires or referees.

- 23 To collect and circulate statistics and other information relating to trade commerce and industry.
 - 24 To secure the best or most favourable tariffs, customs, excise, rebate and other rates, taxes, cesses, town duty, octroi, and local charges and other rates from Government, Semi-Government, railway, steamship, air transport or motor transport authorities or companies of the carriage or transport of commodities in which members of the Association are interested and equitable rules for the ascertaining, levying and collecting of such dues.
 - 25 To take all such steps as may be deemed necessary or advisable or to aid in the establishment and support of all associations, institutors, funds and trusts calculated to promote the uplift of labour to improve the conditions of work, wages and salaries and living conditions of the labouring classes.
 - 26 To affiliate with, subscribe, to become a member of and Co-operate with any other association or body in or outside India, whether incorporated or not, whose objectives are altogether or in part, similar to those of this Association.
 - 27 To form code of ethics or codes of practice in order to simplify and facilitate transaction of business.
 - 28 To maintain uniformity in rules and regulations and usages in various branches of the trade and industry.
 31. To accept any bequest, gift, donation, endowment or subscription from any member of the Association or from any other person or institution, either with or without conditions attached, or otherwise or to establish a fund or endowment for the promotion and attainment of the objects of the Association and to apply the income arising there from or resort to the capital thereof for any objects of the Association.
 32. To amalgamate with or take over, the ownership or management or administration of any other Association, institution or organisation (whether incorporated or not) or Company having objectives altogether similar to those of the Association on such terms and conditions as the Association may think fit and manage the same accordingly.
 33. To create any depreciation fund, reserve funds, sinking fund, insurance fund or any special or other fund, whether for depreciation or for repairing or improving, extending or maintaining any of the property of the Association or for any other purpose as the Association may think fit.
 34. To pay all costs, charges and expenses preliminary and incidental to the promotion and formation of the Association.
 35. To do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objectives of the Association, provided that the Association shall not support with its funds or endeavours to impose on or procure to be observed by its members or others any regulation or restriction which would make the Association a Trade Union.
- (C) OTHER OBJECTIVES:**
36. To undertake any programme or programmes or rural development in the field of irrigation, including the promotion

of social and economical welfare of or the uplift of the public in any rural area.

37. To undertake the training of persons for implementing programmes of rural development.
38. To undertake any programme or programmes of conservation of natural resources and /or protection of environment. to undertake and promote family planning.

V. The Objectives of the Association shall extend to the whole of India.

VI

- 1) The income and property of the Association, whensoever derived, shall be applied solely for the promotion of its objectives as set forth in these by laws.
- 2) No portion of the income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to person, who, at any time are', or have been members of the Association or to any one or more of them or to any person claiming through any one or more of them.
- 3) Except with the previous approval of the Executive Committee no remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the Association to any of its members, whether officers or servants of the Association or not, except payment of out of pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money spent or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to Association.
- 4) Except with the previous approval of the Executive Committee no member shall be appointed to any office

under the Association which is remunerated by salary, fees, or any other manner not excepted by Sub-Clause (3).reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the Association for the time being in force, the accounts of the Association shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year, the Accounts of the Association shall be examined and the correctness of the Balance Sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified Auditor or Auditors.

- 5) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the Association in good faith of reasonable remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person(not being member) in return for any services actually rendered to the Association.

VII No alteration shall be made to these By-Laws and Rules & Regulations which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Executive Committee.


VIII. The liability of the members is limited.

IX. Each member undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Association in the event of its being wound up while he is a member or within one year after he ceases to be member for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Association or of such debts and liabilities of the Association as may be have been contracted before he ceases to be a member and of the costs, charges and expense of winding up and for adjustment of the rights of the contributories amount themselves such amount as may be required not exceeding a sum of Rs. 5000/(Rupees Five Thousand only) per member.

X. True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the Association and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and the liabilities of the Association, and subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the Association for the time being in force, the accounts of the Association shall be open to the inspection the member once at least in every year, the accounts of the Association shall be examined and the correctness of the Balance Sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified Auditor or Auditors.

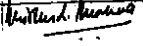

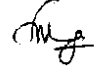
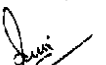
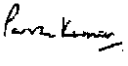
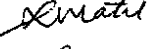


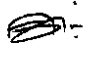

XI. If upon a winding up or dissolution of the Association, there remains, after the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to such other Association having objects similar to the objectives of the Association, to be determined by, the members of the Association at or before the time dissolution or in default thereof, by the High Court of Judicature that has or may acquire jurisdiction in the matter.

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Rules and Regulations of Irrigation Association of India Interpretation

- 01.
- (a) "The Association" Means Irrigation Association of India registered under the provisions of the Public Trust Act.
 - (b) "Members" means only Regular Members under Article of 3A of the Rules and Regulations of the Association and who will be members as per the meaning of the Public Trust Act.
 - (c) "General Meeting" means a General Meeting of the Association.
 - (d) 'The President' means the President of the Association elected from and amongst the members of the committee.
 - (e) "Vice President" means the Vice-President of the Association elected from and amongst the members of the committee.
 - (f) "The Committee" Means the Executive Committee of the Association elected under these rules.
 - (g) "The Hon. Secretary" means the Hon. Secretary of the Association.
 - (h) "The Jt. Secretary and Treasurer" means the Jt. Secretary and Treasurer of the Association. (i) " The office" means the Registered office of the Association for the time being.
 - (i) "The Office" means the 12 calendar months commencing from 1st April and ending on 31st day of March or such other date fixed by the Executive Committee and as may be permissible by law.

- (k) "In writing" means hand written or printed or partly written and partly printed. Words imparting singular member shall include the plural and vice versa.
- (l) "Irrigation" supply of water from a source like pond, well, river, canal, or dam to a standing crop by conveying it from sources using manual. animal, assorted or mechanical means.

MEMBERSHIP

02. The Association shall consist of every person representing the firm, or company that shall be admitted as a member of the association in accordance with these rules.
03. There shall be following categories of members-
- a) Regular Member.
 - b) Associate Member.
 - c) Honorary Member.
 - d) Technical Member.
 - e) International Subscribing Member.
 - f) Affiliate Organisation Member.

(A) Regular Member

Regular Member Regular Member shall be available to a person, firm or company actually engaged in the manufacture of major components of **Micro irrigation** system like **Drip Sprinkar, Pressurized System** etc. with ISI Mark and.

- a) On payment of an entrance fee of Rs.3000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only).
- b) On payment of the Annual Subscription fee for the financial year at the rate for the time being in force and

- c) On complying with the conditions mentioned in Rule 4 hereof.

Explanation.

- i) The word "Person" in this context refers to a sole proprietor of audit which manufacturers components as stated in (A) above.
- ii) A member /representative must be an Indian citizen or person of Indian origin and a resident of India.

(B) Associate Member:

Associate membership shall be available to a person, firm or company other than one qualifying for regular' membership. The person, firm or company must be engaged in distributing or installing irrigation, drainage and erosion control systems or in the business of serving the industry as supplier of raw materials, consultancy with respect to the engineering designing, layout, usage or application of irrigation, drainage erosion control equipments, and

- a) On payment of an entrance fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only).
- b) On payment of the Annual Subscription fee, for the financial year at the rate of the time being in force, and.
- c) On complying with the conditions mentioned in Rule 4 hereof.

Explanation:

- i) A word "Person" (n this context refers a scale proprietor of a unit which manufacturers one/more major components of irrigation.
- ii) A member/representative must be an Indian Citizen or person of Indian Origin and a Resident of India.
- iii) If a member of the Association which is a firm, is converted into a company with limited liability or shall transfer all its business and the assets and liabilities to a company with limited liability, then on the joint application of such firm and such company and subject to the approval and consent of the Executive Committee, such company may be admitted as a member in place of the firm without payment of any admission fee or any additional subscription for the year in which such change takes effect.

(C) HONORARY MEMBER

Honorary membership, not to exceed two in any one year may be extended to any person upon an affirmative vote the majority of the members entitled to vote at any regular or special meeting of the members of the association. The numerical limitation of two shall. not apply in the case of past President of the Association, retired or no longer actively employed in the industry

(D) TECHNICAL MEMBERSHIP

Technical Membership shall be available to University and Government Persons engaged in the study of research in irrigation, interested in engineering design, layout, use or

application of irrigation equipment. The membership and the duration of this membership may be approved by a majority vote of the members entitled to vote at any regular or special meeting of the members of the association.

(E) INTERNATIONAL SUBSCRIBING MEMBERSHIP

International Subscribing membership shall be available to any firm or company outside India engaged in the manufacturing and sale of irrigation, drainage and erosion Control equipments. International subscribing membership may be extended to such firms/companies irrespective of whether they sell their components in India or not, both the membership and the duration of the membership shall be through affirmative vote by the majority of the members of the Association.

(F) AFFILIATE ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP

Affiliate Organization Membership shall be available to any association or society, functioning in India or Abroad to promote the interest of the irrigation industry on a local level. The Membership as well as its duration may be decided upon affirmative vote of the majority of the members of the association.

04. Every Regular Member or every Associate Member shall be admitted as a member of the Association on fulfilling and complying with the following procedures.

- (a) An application shall be made to the Association in the prescribed form giving the details mentioned in the prescribed form and proposed and seconded by existing members.

- b) The entrance fee and the subscription fee, as may be applicable is paid along with the application form.
- c) On receipt of application, same is to be placed before Executive Committee and shall be dealt with in such manner as the Executive Committee may deem fit, the member shall be binding and conclusive on all the Association.

05 ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION & ENTRANCE FEE

- a) The entrance fee and annual subscription of various categories shall be as below.

- b) A Member who is elected any time after the first half of the Association's Financial year shall be liable to pay only one half of the Annual Subscription determined from time to time under Rule 5 (a) (b) hereof.

- c) The annual subscription shall be payable on or before 30th June.

06. If a member of the Association which is a firm is converted into a company with limited liabilities or shall transfer all its business and assets and liabilities to a company with limited

liabilities then on the joint application of such firm and such company and subject to the approval and consent of the Executive Committee, such company may be admitted as a member in the place of the firm without payment of any admission fee or any additional subscription for the year in which such change takes effect.

07. In the case of the firm applying for membership of the Association the partners of the firm must subscribe to the membership, individually.
08. Every member desiring to resign from membership of the Association shall give to the Secretary written notice in that behalf. The Executive Committee shall take note of the resignation at its first meeting after receipt of the notice. No member shall on resignation be entitled to ' refund of the admission fee paid by him for the then current financial year or any part thereof. Every member shall pay to the association all subscriptions and other amounts due and payable by him before his recognition shall take effect.
09. Honorary Members shall be exempted from the payment of the admission fee and yearly subscription and will not be eligible to be elected to the Executive Committee. The above category members shall be entitled to attend and speak at Annual General Meeting of the Association but shall not be entitled to vote at any such meeting. They may be invited to attend the meeting of the Executive Committee but shall not be entitled to votes subject above, they shall have the same rights and privileges and be subject to the objection as the Regular Member of the Association.
10. The rights and privileges of membership may, in case of a firm or a company be exercised by any partner in such firm or by any person authorised by any partner in such firm or 'by

any person authorized by power attorney or letter of procuracy or to the satisfaction of the Executive Committee to sign the name of the firm or to sign such name procuracy any may, in the case of a company or other corporation elected in their corporate name as a member of the Association) be exercised by a Director, Manager, Secretary or any other responsible officer of the company or corporation or a person authorised by power of attorney to exercise the same or any other person, who in the opinion of the Executive Committee, is competent to exercise the same on behalf of the company or corporation, subject nevertheless to be following reservations, namely-

- i) Every representative of a firm, company or other corporation entitled to exercise the rights and privileges of membership must have his name registered in the books of the Association in order to exercise the aforesaid right and privileges.
 - ii) For each act of exercise of the rights and privileges of membership by a firm company or other corporation member, only one representative shall vote.
- (B) Every firm and every company which is member of the Association shall . by intimation in writing given to the. Secretary, from time to time, nominate a representative who shall be eligible for election as the President or Vice-.Resident or Hon. Secretary or Jt. Secretary of the Association or as a member of the Executive Committee and for appointment on any Regional Committee or any other committee or subcommittee of the Association and shall further intimate which of the such representatives is authorised to vote on behalf of the firm at General Meeting of the Association4No firm which is member

shall at any time have more than one representative on the Executive Committee

- (C) If any representative of a firm or a company which is a member of the Association shall cease to be a partner of the firm or a Director or other representative of the company or his nomination as representative shall for that or any other reason to be force, or if the firm or company shall cease to be a member, and if, as such representatives he shall be the President or vice-president or a member of the Executive Committee of any other committee he shall forthwith cease to hold such office.

12. A member of the Association shall cease to be a member on the happening of any of the following events.

- a) if he resigns by giving notice in the manner provided article 9 above.
- b) If he fails to pay subscription outstanding for a financial year and /or any other some due by him to the Association for the period of the one month after notice shall be given to him by the. Executive Committee in that behalf and such a defaulting member shall not be eligible for election or have a right to vote, not withstanding, the fact that notice as above might not have been served on such a member.
- c) If he being and individual is adjudicated insolvent.

- d) If a member is a firm is dissolved or any partner thereof is adjudicated insolvent.
- e) If a member is a company or an Association is taken into liquidation voluntary or compulsory.
- f) If a member being 'an individual is adjusted by a competent court to be of unsound mind or is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- g) If he is expelled or his membership is terminated under the provision of these rules.

13. VOTING RIGHTS

Only all Regular Members of the Association shall have voting rights.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

14. The Executive Committee members shall not be less than 10 and shall not be more than 31.
15. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by an Executive Committee which shall consist of the following
 - (a) The Vice President 1 No.
 - (b) The Hon. Secretary 4 Nos.
 - (c) The Jt. Secretary 1 No.

Treasurer

- (e) Three members co-opted by the Executive Committee as hereinafter provided under Rule 21.
 - (f) Immediate Past. President as the ex-officio member.
 - (g) Balance Member-5 shall be elected by the Meeting of the Association at the Annual General Meeting as hereinafter provided.
16. Executive Committee members and office bearers shall hold office for two years. No member shall continue to be member of Executive Committee beyond 2 years without election by General Meeting.
17. No person shall hold the office of President for more than two consecutive terms. A person who shall have been President shall be eligible for election again as President after the lapse of a year or more. Subject thereto the President. The Vice President the Hon. Secretary, the Jt. Secretary and the members of the Executive Committee shall be eligible for re-election at the Annual General Meeting.
18. Four Vice-President shall be from 4 regions as below..
- i) **Western Region-** Maharashtra, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Goa, Chattisgarh.
 - ii) **Southern Region-** Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Kerala, Pondicherry.
- iii) **Northern Region.** Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Harayana, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Uttaranchal.
 - iv) **Eastern Region.** West Bengal, Orissa, Assam, Meghayala, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Zarkhand.
19. The Executive Committee shall fill casual vacancies in the office of the President or Vice-President or Hon Secretary or Jt. Secretary from elected members of the Executive Committee. Every such casual vacancy shall be filled from among the members of the association who shall be qualified for election thereto.
20. The Executive Committee shall first try and decide on the office bearers by unanimous choice. Failing unanimity the election shall be held by voice vote failing which election by secret ballot shall be held and the manner of committee members indicating their preference votes for each candidate shall be adopted. Thus, first preference votes fro each candidate shall be the highest and last preference vote shall be the least.
21. The Executive Committee elected under Rule 15 shall from among the members of the Association not more than 3 additional members on the committee. Subject to these limits, the member of co-opted members of the committee shall be such as may be decided from time to time by the committee elected pursuant to Rule 15. Such co-opted members shall hold for the year upto the Annual General Meeting or for such shorter period as the committee may determine from time to time.
22. All the above offices of the Executive Committee shall be honorary.

- a) The President and failing him the Senior Most Vice President shall preside over meetings of Executive Committee. Failing the President, the members present shall elect a chairman for the meeting.
 - b) If personally the President, Vice-President, or any member of the Executive Committee shall fail to attend three consecutive meetings of the Committee or from all meetings within three months except with leave of absence previously obtained from the Committee he shall cease to hold office.
 - c) The Executive Committee shall meet as and so often as they shall think fit but at least once in every two calendar month.
 - d) The quorum for a meeting of the Executive Committee shall be 1/3 (one third) of the total strength for time being of the committee, or 5 members of the Committee whichever is lower. The President and Vice Presidents shall also be counted for the purpose of quorum. If a meeting of the committee could not be held for want of quorum then the meeting shall stand adjourned till the same day in the next week at the same time and place or if that day is a public holiday, till the next succeeding day which is not a public holiday, at the same time and place. If at the adjourned meeting also there is not quorum, the members present shall constitute a quorum, provided that the Executive Committee may also fix some other day as they deem fit after giving a fresh notice in that behalf before the adjourned meeting takes place.
24. The Executive Committee may appoint Executive Director or an Executive Secretary on such remuneration and other terms and conditions as the Executive Committee shall think fit to supervise and observe the affairs of the Association under the supervision, direction and control of the Executive Director or the Executive Secretary and appoint such other person in his place. The Executive Director/ Executive Secretary shall perform such acts or the duties of the Association as may be directed by the Executive Committee.
 25. The Executive committee shall have full power to do all such acts as they may deem necessary and conducive or incidental to the attainment and promotion of any of the objectives of the Association, and shall have full control of all activities and functions of the association as laid down in the By-laws and shall have full control of the staff, funds and property of the Association. And power to transact all business of the Association and to incur all the necessary expenditure. The Executive Committee shall also have power to appoint and from time to time remove such Executive Secretary, Executive Director clerk, and other servants as the Committee may think fit and to fix, determine their remuneration and terms and conditions of service.
 26. The Executive committee may from time to time appoint Sub-Committee for special or particular purpose and shall have power to co-opt on any such Sub-Committee any member of the association or the representative of any member which shall be a firm, association or company who shall not be a member of the Executive Committee and may delegate to any such committee the functions and powers of the Executive (Committee relating thereto to be exercised subject to report to approval of Executive Committee.

STATE CHAPTERS

27. The Executive Committee may whenever they think necessary or cause to be constituted on State Chapter for any state and from time to time abolish the same. As far as possible the name of the State Chapter shall be in line with national level association i.e. Irrigation Association of India (State name) chapter.
28. Any such State chapter shall exercise such power and perform such functions as may be delegated to it by Executive Committee of the Association from time to time. Such State chapter shall be guided by State Committees consisting of
- (a) All the members Executive Committee of the chapter belonging to the State
 - (b) Members of the State chapter Committee elected by all members

The State chapter Committee shall function under the control of Executive Committee of the IAI.

29. Every State chapter Committee referred in Rules 27 to 28 shall function primarily with a view to look after affairs of that particular state with the help of them Association and shall provide secretarial services to the Divisional Committee if any, of the, chapter in that state.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

30. The financial year of the Association shall be from the 1st April to 31st March or such other date fixed by the

Executive Committee as may be permissible by law and the account of the Association shall be balanced upto the end of the financial year.

- 31.(a) The Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held every year within six months from the date of closing accounts required by law on the date as the Executive Committee may decide, at the Office of the Association or at such place in India as the Executive Committee may be decide subject to the provision of the act for the purpose of transaction of the following business.
- i) To consider the Annual Report of the Association and the Audited Statement of Accounts.
 - ii) To elect Members of the Executive Committee as the case may be.
 - iii) To appoint an auditor or auditors for the ensuing year and to fix their remuneration.
 - iv) To consider and decide on any resolution which may be duly submitted to the meeting as hereinafter provided.
- (b) A statement shall be annexed to the Annual Report giving the following information
- i) A list of members who have not paid their subscription on the due dates along with the amount of subscription outstanding.
 - ii) A break-up of the income under significant heads due to the Association in the financial year and/or the past financial years and which have not been received during or by the end of the financial year of the Annual Report.

32 (a) Not less than eight weeks before the date fixed for each Annual General Meeting after every two years. The secretary shall send to every member association a list the members of the Association who shall be qualified to be elected to the Executive Committee including in case of each member firm or member company its representative who shall be qualified for election, under article (II) or representative who shall desire to stand for election as member of the Executive Committee for the ensuing years to send his nomination. The Hon. Secretary shall the state

(b) Immediately on receipt of nominations as per Sub - Rule (a) above, the secretary shall send to all the candidates and the respective members a list of all nominations received and a candidate may thereafter withdraw his 'candidature by notice in writing to the secretary notice of withdrawal shall be signed by the candidate himself and should reach the secretary within ten days at the latest from the date of the list of nominations received by him.

(c) Every member of the Association shall be entitled to attend the Annual General meeting of the Association either in person of his nominees and the Auditor of the Association shall have right to attend and to be heard and to be heard at any Annual General meeting on any part of the business which concern him as auditor.

(d) All the members who have their office outside the Pune as per the records of the Association shall be entitled to exercise their rights to vote for the election of the members of the committee by post.

Like all other members such members shall be entitled to as many votes as there are places to be filled in by election in each category and shall further be entitled to cast only one

vote for any one candidate. The association shall least 14 days prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting send to such members a ballot paper' setting' out the names of the persons whose nominations have been received for the election to the Committee. Such members may fill in the ballot paper, seal it in an envelope, write a forward letter or note duly signed by the authorised representative of the member firm. The ballot paper shall not be signed. The sealed envelope containing the ballot paper on and the forwarding letter shall be enclosed in another envelop and sent by Registered A.D. to the Secretary of the Association. The ballot papers sent by post and not received atleast twenty-four hours prior to the date of election shall not be considered for voting.

33 No resolution other the resolution relating to the adoption of the Annual Report and Accounts,) the election of the members of the Executive Committee and the appointment of the auditors shall be moved at the Annual General Meeting unless a notice in writing signed by the members who proposed and second it setting out the resolution shall be sent to the secretary not less than four weeks before the time appointed for holding such meeting

AUDIT

34. The accounts of the Association shall be audited by a duly qualified Auditor or Auditors who shall be appointed by the members at each Annual General meeting for the then ensuing financial year and their remuneration fixed. A vacancy /occurring in the course of the year shall be filled by alternate Auditors to be nominated by the Executive Committee.

EXTRA – ORDSINARY GENERAL MEETING

- 35. (a) An Extra- Ordinary General Meeting may be called by the Executive Committee at any time as they desire.
- (b) Upon a requisition members in accordance with the provisions of rule an Extra-Ordinary General meeting shall be called by the Executive Committee in accordance with rules.

GENERAL MEETINGS

- 36. Notice of every Annual or Other General Meetings specifying the place, the day and hour of the meting, and a statement of business to be transacted at the meeting, shall be given to all members not less than fourteen clear days before the day fixed for holding such meeting in a manner hereinafter mentioned. Such notice shall specify the date
- 37. At all Annual General Meetings or Special General Meetings the President of the Association shall preside. Failing the President, the senior most Vice President shall preside, failing the President and Vice President the members present shall elect a Chairman for the meeting.
- 38.
 - a) At all General Meetings the quorum of the members shall be five.
 - b) If within half an hour from the time appointed for any General Meeting a quorum is not present, the meeting if converted upon the requisition of members shall be dissolved. In any other case, it shall stand adjourned to the day to be decided at the next meeting of the Executive & Committee. At such adjourned meeting the members then

present shall dispose off the work which was to have been placed the original meeting and the members present shall form a quorum.

- c) At every General Meeting every member of the Association which is a firm. association or company shall be entitled to be represented by its representative. Every ordinary member who being an individual shall be present in person and every ordinary member which being a firm, association or company shall be represented by one representative shall have one vote (such vote being given in the case of a firm, association or company only by the representative specially authorized in that behalf and every such firm, association or company having irrespective of the number of its representatives present cast only one vote) .
- d) Voting shall (except in the case provided for or covered by Rule 38 or of a special Resolution) be by a majority of votes and on an equality of votes the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote.

EXPULSION

39

- a) The Association shall be entitled at any time to expel any member of the association or to terminate his membership (whether such member be an individual. firm, association or company) if he 'be found guilty of conduct which the Association regards as rendering him unfit to be a member of the Association.
- b) No such expulsion or termination a member shall be valid or effective.

- i) Unless the proposal is considered at a Special General Meeting of the Association called on a notice in which the proposition to considered and the reasons which have prompted the proposal are set out in full.
 - ii) Unless the member concerned is given not less than 10 days notice and an opportunity to attend the meeting and is heard by the members assembled at the meeting, the members concerned being entitled to appear, in case of a firm, association or company by its representative or representatives specially authorized in that behalf and
 - iii) Unless the proposal is passed by a majority of not less than three fourths of the members present at the meeting whether voting or not.
- c) On a member being expelled or his membership being terminated in accordance with the provisions of the Bye-laws shall cease to be member and he shall have no right or claim against the Association or any member thereof for damages, compensation or otherwise howsoever.

FUNDS

40. The funds of the Association shall be deposited in approved banks and such part thereof as shall not be required for current expenses may at the discretion of the Committee, be invested in any investments for the time being authorised by the law of India for the investment of Trust Funds and such investments shall not be sold or dealt with except at the direction of the Executive Committee. The Accounts with banks shall be operated upon by means of cheque signed by

two office bearers i.e the President or one Vice President or Hon. Secretary or Jt. Secretary Treasurer or Executive Secretary Members of the Committee specially authorised in this behalf. Any cheque received by the Association shall be endorsed by the Hon. Secretary or the Jr. Secretary or the Treasures or the President or the Vice President in favour of the banks to be credited there to the account of the Association.

SEAL

41. The Seal of the Association shall not be affixed to any document except by the Authority of a resolution of the Executive Committee and in the presence of a least two persons namely, the President or Vice-President or Hon. Secretary or Jt. Secretary or Treasurer or a member or members of the Committee and such other person or persons as the Committee may appoint for the purpose, and they shall sign every instrument to which the seal of the to which seal of the Association is so affixed in their presence. The seal shall always be in the safe custody of the Executive Committee.

NOTICE

42. a) A Notice may be given by the association to any member either personally or by sending it by post to such member to his registered address or (if he has on registered address in India) to the address if any within India supplied by him to the Association for the giving of notice to him.
- b) In case of a members who is a firm association or company the notice shall be given to the firm, association or company or to the principle officer of the firm association or company.

c) Where a notice is sent by post service of the notice shall be deemed to be effected by properly addressing pre-paying and posting a letter containing the notice and unless the contrary is provided to have been effected at the time at which the letter would be delivered in ordinary course of the post except where otherwise stated.

43. If a member has no registered address in India and has not supplied to the Association an address within India for the giving of notices to him, notice addressed to him and advertised in a newspaper circulating in the neighbourhood of the Registered Office of the Association shall be deemed duly given to him on the day on which the advertisement appears.
44. No member of Association shall be subject to any liability beyond payment of the subscription and except as provided by the By-Law of the Association.
45. The Rules of Association shall not be altered or amended unless the proposal to make alter or amend is passed by a majority of not less than three fourth of the members of the association, voting either in person or by postal ballot at a General Meeting of the Association of which notice shall be given at least 14 clear days before the date of meeting giving particulars of the proposed enactments, alternations, or amendments.
