
As part of this initiative, all empanelled Micro Irrigation (MI) companies have submitted their formal consent letters through IAI. The policy mandates that:

Central Marks Department (CMD) under the Bureau of Indian Standard has issued the Indian Standard BIS 12786:2024



The Central Marks Department (CMD) under the Bureau of Indian Standard has issued the Indian Standard BIS 12786:2024 for manufacturing of Polyethylene pipes for irrigation laterals. The Indian standard provides manufacturing companies with detailed specifications outlining the quality of raw materials to be used by companies in the manufacturing process. In addition to the quality of raw material, the standard also includes provisions permitting laser printing on pipes for marking product related information. While the Bureau's standard aims to provide manufacturing companies

with guidelines and a clear criterion for maintaining uniformity in the quality of all products being manufactured and supplied to consumers in the open markets; the irrigation industry envisages certain practical challenges in the implementation of the new provisions.

The Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs (CBIC), under the Government of India, has announced a significant reduction in Goods and Services Tax (GST) rates for a wide range of items related

to farming and agriculture. Under the revised structure, the GST on tractors and tractor tyres has been reduced from 12% to 5% and from 18% to 5% respectively; while, farm inputs like bio-pesticides and micronutrients will attract a GST of only 5%. The revised tax structure is all set to have a significant impact on the irrigation industry as well with critical farm equipment essential for water conservation and modern farming practices such as drip and sprinkler irrigation systems falling under the 5% tax bracket.



The announcement made by the Hon. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi at India's 76th Independence Day celebrations has described the reforms as "The next generation of GST reforms are a gift for every Indian this Diwali. These changes are expected to lower costs for farmers, promote mechanisation, and encourage the adoption of modern agricultural technologies." The move aimed at easing the financial burden on farmers, boosting rural development, and making essential agricultural equipment more affordable will come into effect across the country from 22nd September 2025.

# PM Modi says 100 underperforming farm districts will be elevated to match other farming regions



The Hon. Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the PM Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana, a Rs 24,000 crore initiative aimed at uplifting 100 underperforming agricultural districts in the country. Under the scheme 100 underperforming agricultural districts will be brought at par with other farming regions through an improvement in productivity, crop diversification; and infrastructure expansion including storage and irrigation facilities and an increase in credit access. The government has identified 100 districts lagging in farming and launched the campaign to empower farmers under the PM Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana.

# Agriculture's biggest challenge today is rampant infiltration of counterfeit, adulterated inputs: R G Agarwal, Dhanuka Agritech



Counterfeit, duplicate and adulterated agricultural inputs pose one of the biggest challenges of the agricultural sector. The use of spurious fertilizers, pesticides, and seeds is resulting in crop failure and income losses. Further, the on-going global trade situation is affecting India's farm input businesses leading to higher costs, longer lead times and changes in global prices.

Here effective supply chain management and operational efficiency will be the key to remaining competitive in the market. Additional strategies to strengthen the agri-input

industry could include import source diversification complemented by indigenous capacity development. In order to combat counterfeit agri-inputs, the industry could consider the introduction of robust traceability solutions with products marked with unique identification codes allowing farmers to authenticate inputs effectively.

## EU plans new subsidies for farmers to save water

The European Commission has drafted plans to provide new subsidies to farmers who adopt watersaving practices, according to a draft proposal seen by Reuters. This initiative is part of the European Union's Common Agricultural Policy (CAP), a major subsidy programme worth approximately ₹387 billion for 2021–2027, representing about a third of the EU's total budget.



EU member states are preparing for intensive negotiations later this year on the next post-2027 budget, with water-efficient agriculture expected to be a key priority. These subsidies aim to encourage sustainable farming practices, reduce water waste, and strengthen climate resilience across the bloc.

# UAE – Water-Saving Demonstration Farms and Drip Technology



In Abu Dhabi, demonstration farms using "inline pressure compensating driplines" and adjustable drip systems in the Western Region are achieving about 46% water savings while maintaining yields. Over 90% of farms in the region have been given access to efficient irrigation systems, and more than 6,000 workers have been trained in water-saving techniques
